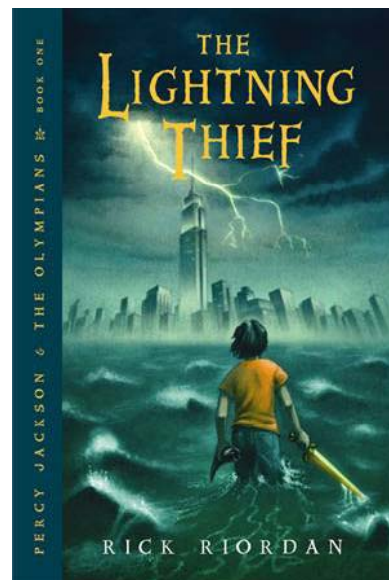
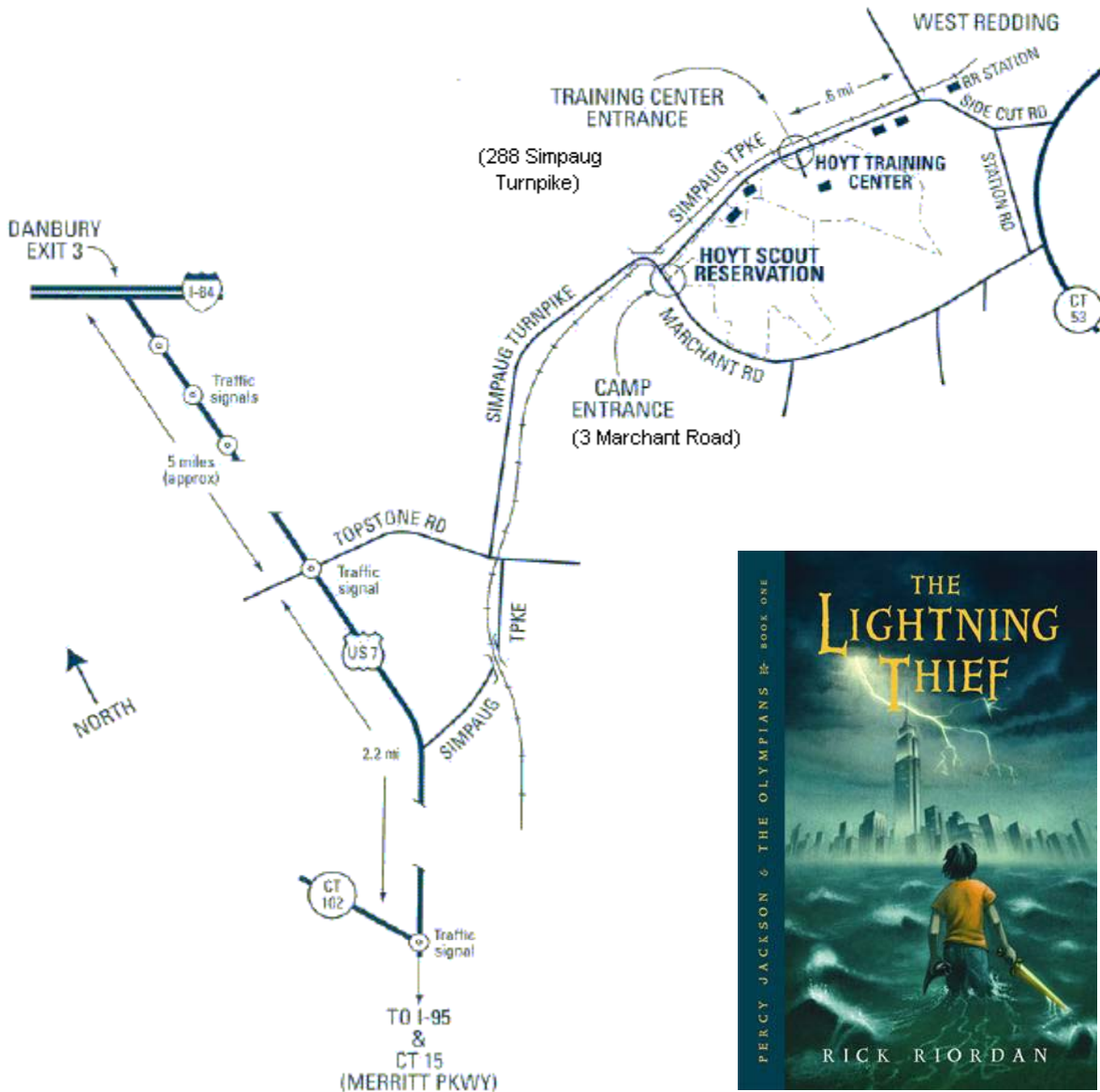
From I-95 or CT 15 (Merritt Parkway)
